Tuition and Enrollment Update

This year, with the congregation's support, tuition rates will remain the same for member and non-member families with up to two children in K-8. There is now a family discount, tuition will not exceed the two-child rate, no matter how many siblings enroll. We are also offering a \$500 tuition credit for both your family and any new family you recruit to St. Paul! Enrollment for Preschool and K-8 is open for 2025-2026! Current families have received a FACTS reenrollment email. **K-8 registration is now \$450 until June 10th** (\$500 thereafter). **Preschool registration remains at \$150.**
